1.	1 June 2023	Declare your intention to submit your paper in an email to George Fowler (gfowler@indiana.edu)
2.	15 September 2023	Submit paper on line (details to follow) in LaTeX or Word format (templates will be made available for download shortly, containing also style sheet information). Anonymize the submission version as far as is reasonable
3.	1 November 2023	Comments from editors and reviewers returned to authors for revisions as needed
4.	15 January 2024	Revised (final) versions returned to editors
5.	1 March 2024	Editors turn articles over to Lanko Marusic for production. Publication of each article will occur as it is ready for posting online

Some slippage in this timeline is to be expected, but we wanted to set an aggressive schedule in the hope that this will establish a "new normal" for future FASL conferences.

Very important: We need several volunteers to join George Fowler as co-editors. George will handle logistics and some papers, but we'd like the co-editors to take charge of a batch of papers in their area of expertise. Talk to George here or email him after the conference. At the conference several volunteers came forward: Wayles Browne, Damir Ćavar, Malgorzata Ćavar, Van Holtenrichs, Jordan Hussey-Andersen, Catherine Rudin. We probably don't need additional editors...

We will expect authors submitting papers to also help us a bit with refereeing.

Non-native speakers of English: It is a good idea to get a native speaker to read and vet the English in advance of submission, at least of the final version. The editors won't have time to do a thorough job on this given the accelerated timetable.
